



## Take Your Shot Giveaway Official Rules

The Take Your Shot Giveaway (the “Drawing”) is open to legal residents of the 50 states of the United States of America and the District of Columbia excluding Washington (collectively, the “USA”) who are registered participants of the 2026 RMEF Full Draw Powered by Total Archery Challenge (“TAC”) event. Entries received from outside the USA will not be considered. The Drawing is subject to all applicable federal, state, and local laws and regulations. **Void in other countries, U.S. territories, and where prohibited or restricted by law.**

### Important Notice for Washington State Residents

Due to state regulations, nonprofit organizations are not permitted to offer promotional contests or sweepstakes as commonly advertised. Washington law allows only two types of prize drawings: Raffles, which may only be conducted by qualified nonprofits and require a ticket purchase with no free method of entry, and Promotional contests, which are limited to businesses and must offer a free way to participate. Because nonprofits like ours are not eligible to run promotional contests, we are unable to extend sweepstakes-style offers in Washington State. If you would like to see this law changed to allow nonprofit organizations to run sweepstakes promotions with free entry options — just as businesses can — we encourage you to contact your state legislators. **Eligibility.** The Drawing is open only to legal residents of the USA who are at least 18 years old at the time of entry (“Entrant”). Employees of the Rocky Mountain Elk Foundation, their immediate family members (spouse, parent, child, sibling), and members of the same household are not eligible to enter. This promotion is void where prohibited.

**Sponsor.** The Drawing is sponsored and administered by the Rocky Mountain Elk Foundation (“RMEF”), 5705 Grant Creek Road, Missoula, MT 59808.

**Agreement to Official Rules.** By entering, Entrants agree to be bound by these Official Rules and the decisions of RMEF, which are final and binding in all respects relating to the Drawing. Winning a prize is contingent upon fulfilling all requirements set forth in these Official Rules.

**How to Enter.** Participation in this giveaway is limited exclusively to registered participants of the 2026 RMEF Full Draw Powered by TAC event. Entries must be received between 12:00:00 a.m. Mountain Daylight Time (MDT) on February 23, 2026, and 11:59:59 p.m. MDT on June 22, 2026 (the “Drawing Period”). RMEF’s computer system is the official timekeeping device.

There is no limit to the number of chances an eligible participant may purchase; each \$25 purchase constitutes one (1) separate entry. All entries must be properly completed and submitted in accordance with the instructions on the official landing page to be valid.

Methods of Entry:

1. **RMEF’s Website Purchase:** To enter, eligible participants must navigate to the official landing page [2026 Shoot RMEF at Full Draw Powered by TAC with the Experts | Rocky Mountain Elk Foundation](#) and complete the purchase of one (1) chance for \$25 with the expert of their choice in accordance with the instructions provided on the page. Participants may purchase multiple chances at \$25 per chance, each constituting a separate entry.

All entries become the exclusive property of RMEF and will not be acknowledged or returned. Entries that are incomplete, fraudulent, corrupted, or otherwise non-compliant with these rules, as determined by RMEF in its sole discretion, will be disqualified.

**Random Drawing and Notification.** RMEF or its agent will conduct one (1) random drawing to select four (4) potential prize winners from among all eligible entries received during the Drawing Period. The drawing will occur on or about Monday, June 29, 2026. The potential winner will be contacted via telephone, email or physical mail. If the selected

winner is unreachable, ineligible, fails to respond within **fourteen (14)** calendar days, or does not comply with the rules, an alternate winner may be selected at RMEF's sole discretion.

Online entries are deemed to be made by the Authorized Account Holder of the e-mail address submitted at time of entry. Authorized Account Holder means the natural person who is assigned to an email address by an Internet access provider, online service provider, or other entity that is responsible for assigning email addresses for the domain associated with the submitted email address.

**Chances of Winning a Prize.** The odds of winning depend on the total number of eligible entries received.

**Prizes.** Each winner will receive an exclusive opportunity to attend the 2026 RMEF Full Draw Powered by TAC event on held in Missoula, Montana on either July 17 and 18 and participate in a shoot alongside an OutdoorClass instructor (the "Experience"). The following prize(s) will be awarded in this Drawing:

- **One (1) Winner to Shoot TAC with Remi Warren** (Approximate Retail Value: \$400.00).
- **One (1) Winner to Shoot TAC with Corey Jacobsen** (ARV: \$400.00).
- **One (1) Winner to Shoot TAC with Jason Matzinger** (ARV: \$400.00).
- **One (1) Winner to Shoot TAC with Kristy Titus** (ARV: \$400.00).

Total approximate retail value of all prizes: \$1600.00. ARV is based on RMEF's goodfaith estimate of the fair market value of a oneday professionalled archery experience with a nationally recognized expert. Actual value may vary.-faith estimate of the fair market value of a one-day professional-led archery experience with

**Experience Details.** The Experience includes on-site attendance at a designated TAC event and a one-day guided, observational and participatory shooting experience alongside an OutdoorClass instructor. Actual activities may vary based on event schedule, weather, safety requirements, and the professional hunter's availability.

In the event an individual is selected as a winner for more than one instructor, that individual shall be permitted to select the instructor whom they prefer to participate, subject to availability. Upon such selection, any additional prize(s) awarded to that individual for other instructors shall be deemed forfeited and may be awarded to alternative winner(s) at Sponsor's sole discretion.

**Inclusions:**

- i. Participation in an experience shoot session conducted in accordance with event rules and safety protocols
- ii. Meet-and-greet and interaction with the OutdoorClass instructor

**Not Included:**

- i. Travel, lodging, meals, transportation, or incidentals (unless expressly stated otherwise)
- ii. Bows, equipment, or gear (winner must provide their own approved equipment, if permitted by the event)

All prize details are at the sole discretion of RMEF and subject to change or substitution of equal or greater value. No transfer, substitution, or cash equivalent of any prize is permitted, except at RMEF's sole discretion. Any taxes, fees, or other costs associated with prize acceptance and use are the sole responsibility of the winner(s).

**In-Person Attendance Required.** To be eligible to receive the prize, winners must attend in person the 2026 RMEF Full Draw Powered by TAC event, scheduled to take place in Missoula, Montana on July 17 and July 18, 2026. Prizes will be awarded on-site at the event at a time and location designated by RMEF, in its sole discretion.

**Integration with Event Schedule.** Participants acknowledge and agree that TAC course schedules, including previously assigned or original knock times, may be modified, reassigned, or adjusted to accommodate reserved shooting times for participating professional experts and selected winners. Any such modifications shall be determined by RMEF and/or event organizers in their sole discretion to ensure the safe and effective execution of the experience.

**Failure to Attend or Participate.** RMEF is not responsible for a selected winner's failure to attend the event, be present at the designated time and location for prize fulfillment, or otherwise comply with these Official Rules. Any selected winner who is not present as required, or who fails to meet eligibility or participation requirements, may forfeit the prize, which may be awarded to an alternate winner at RMEF's sole discretion.

**Event-Related Limitations.** RMEF shall not be responsible for delays, cancellations, modifications, or interruptions to the event or prize experience resulting from weather, safety concerns, scheduling changes, acts of third parties, or other circumstances beyond RMEF's reasonable control.

**Standards of Conduct.** Each winner agrees to conduct themselves at all times in a respectful, responsible, and sportsmanlike manner while participating in the promotion, attending the event, and engaging in any prize-related activities.

**Prohibited Conduct.** RMEF reserves the right to disqualify or remove a winner from participation if the winner engages in conduct that RMEF, the event organizers, or any participating professional, in their sole discretion, determine to be inappropriate, unsafe, disruptive, or inconsistent with the spirit of the event, including but not limited to:

- i. Violating any applicable law, regulation, event rule, safety protocol, or venue policy;
- ii. Engaging in reckless, dangerous, or unsafe behavior, including unsafe handling or use of archery equipment;
- iii. Harassment, intimidation, offensive conduct, or inappropriate language directed toward other participants, event staff, professionals, volunteers, or spectators;
- iv. Being under the influence of alcohol, illegal drugs, or controlled substances in a manner that could pose a safety or conduct concern;
- v. Conduct that may damage the reputation or goodwill of RMEF, event organizers, or participating professionals.

**Removal and Disqualification.** RMEF reserves the right, in its sole discretion, to immediately remove a winner from the event, terminate the prize experience, and/or disqualify the winner from the event if the winner fails to comply with these conduct standards. In such event, the winner may forfeit the prize in whole or in part, and RMEF shall have no obligation to provide any substitute prize, compensation, or reimbursement.

**No Liability for Forfeiture.** RMEF shall not be responsible or liable for any loss, damage, or expense incurred by a winner as a result of removal, disqualification, or forfeiture due to a violation of this conduct requirement.

**Event Authority Preserved.** Winner acknowledges that event organizers, venue staff, and participating professionals retain full authority to enforce safety rules, event policies, and conduct standards, and RMEF's decisions regarding conduct and enforcement shall be final and binding.

**Additional Prize Conditions.** Each winner may be required to sign and return a prize release, waiver and tax forms within **fourteen (14)** calendar days of initial notification.

Prize winners must demonstrate legal eligibility to take possession of the prize and comply with all applicable federal, state, and local laws, including BATF and DMV requirements depending on the prize

Failure to respond, provide necessary documentation, or comply with these Official Rules within the required time may result in disqualification and selection of an alternate winner at RMEF's sole discretion.

No prize substitutions, cash equivalents, or transfers are permitted except at the sole discretion of RMEF. If the prize becomes unavailable, RMEF may substitute a prize of equal or greater value. The ARV is based on pricing at the time these rules were published and may fluctuate. Any difference between the stated ARV and actual value will not be awarded.

The winner's name, likeness, statements, and other entry materials may be used by RMEF for promotional purposes in all media without further compensation, unless prohibited by law. The winner is responsible for all applicable taxes and will receive a 1099-MISC or equivalent form for the ARV of the prize.

**General Conditions.** RMEF reserves the right to cancel, suspend, or modify the Drawing for any reason, including but not limited to fraud, technical issues, or any factor that impairs the integrity of the Drawing. RMEF may disqualify any individual it suspects of tampering with the entry process or violating these Official Rules.

Any attempt to deliberately damage any website or undermine the operation of the Drawing is a violation of criminal and civil laws. RMEF reserves the right to seek damages to the fullest extent permitted by law.

Failure by RMEF to enforce any term of these Official Rules shall not constitute a waiver. In case of a dispute regarding an email entry, the authorized account holder of the email address used to enter will be deemed the Entrant.

RMEF is not responsible for any typographical or other error in the printing of the offer, administration of the Drawing or in the announcement of any prize or for any suspension of the Drawing or inability to implement the Drawing or award the prizes as contemplated herein due to any "force majeure" event beyond its control, including delays or interruptions caused by acts of God, acts of war, natural disasters, pandemic, weather, utility outages, acts of terrorism or any federal, state, or local government law, order, or regulation, order of any court or regulator.

**Release & Limitation of Liability.** By entering, Entrants release and hold harmless RMEF and its respective officers, employees, volunteers, affiliates, sponsors, and agents (“Released Parties”) from any and all liability arising from participation, acceptance, possession, use, or misuse of the prize(s), including but not limited to injury, death, or property damage. Released Parties are not responsible for technical failures or errors, unauthorized human intervention, entry data corruption, lost, delayed, misdirected, or damaged entries or mail, or other causes beyond their control. Entrants waive any right to claim punitive, incidental, or consequential damages, and any implied warranties related to the prize. All prizes are awarded “as-is.”

**Use of Data.** Personal information collected during the Drawing will be used in accordance with RMEF’s Privacy Policy, available at: <https://www.rmef.org/policies/privacy-policy/>. By entering, Entrants consent to the use of their information as described therein.

**Disputes.** Except where prohibited, all disputes arising out of or relating to this Drawing or any prize(s) shall be resolved individually, without resorting to class action, and exclusively by the appropriate court located in the State of Montana. These Official Rules shall be governed by the laws of the State of Montana, without regard to its conflict of law provisions. ANY CLAIMS, JUDGMENTS AND/OR AWARDS SHALL BE LIMITED TO ACTUAL OUT-OF-POCKET COSTS ASSOCIATED WITH ENTERING THIS DRAWING. ENTRANT HEREBY WAIVES ANY RIGHTS OR CLAIMS TO ATTORNEY’S FEES, INDIRECT, SPECIAL, PUNITIVE, INCIDENTAL OR CONSEQUENTIAL DAMAGES OF ENTRANT, WHETHER FORESEEABLE OR NOT and WHETHER BASED ON NEGLIGENCE OR OTHERWISE.
